

Student Academic Rights

If you believe your academic rights have been violated, or you have any academic issue, you may take the following steps:

| Before contacting the Academic Ombud, have you tried the following? |
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| \square Discuss the issue with the course instructor or advisor. |
| \square Meet with the Program Director or Department Chair to discuss the issue. |
| \Box If there is no resolution, or you would like advice on resolving the issue, contact the Academic Ombud. |
| Contact Academic Ombud: ombud@uky.edu 257-3737 |
| \Box Contact Academic Ombud as soon as possible, and within 180 days of the semester in which the issue occurred. |
| ☐ Collect all documentation that might support your perspective (e.g., course syllabus, emails, canvas messages, grades, etc.). |
| \square Request a meeting with the Academic Ombud to share your perspective. |
| \square Grant the Academic Ombud permission to try to resolve the issue. |
| If you should submit an appeal |
| \square Submit your letter of appeal and supporting documents, according to the instructions provided. |
| ☐ The Academic Ombud will request a response from the Instructor, Program Director, Chair or appropriate University official. |
| \square The Academic Ombud will file your appeal with the Hearing Panel Clerk. |
| \square If your appeal has merit, the Hearing Panel Clerk will schedule a hearing and invite you to attend. |
| \Box If your appeal does not have merit, you have 30 days to appeal that decision to the Hearing Panel. |
| If the Hearing Panel will review the case documents to determine whether they should hear your case. If they decide to hear the case, they will schedule a hearing and invite you to attend. |
| ☐ The decisions of the Hearing Panel are final. The Hearing Panel will notify the student, instructor, and appropriate University officials of their decision. |
